

AZ VFW JROTC Cadet of the Year Application

This VFW Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps (JROTC) Cadet of the Year application must be completed and submitted **DIRECTLY** to a VFW Post in your community by March 1st.

Eligibility:

- Be between the ages of 15 and 18 (Applicants still in high school who reach their 18th birthday during the school year remain eligible if otherwise qualified).
- Enrolled in high school JROTC in Arizona at time of selection.

Documentation Required:

- **Photograph** – The Cadet must appear in correct, complete uniform for their current rank. Recommended photo size 3”x5”.
- **High School Participation Record** – a single page, single sided resume of the candidate’s high school activities indicating academic achievements, offices held, honors received, and significant participation in other activities.
- **JROTC Record** – maximum of 3 pages, one sided, listing all JROTC accomplishments and participation. Include camps, training received, teams participated on, duties, and competitions participated in.
- **Community Service Record** – a single page, one sided, resume listing participation in community and religious service organizations, noting leadership positions held and any recognition received.
- **Letters of recommendation** – Submit three letters no more than two pages in length, single sided, from:
